

ZINFANDEL 2022



VINEYARD & VINTAGE

This year's stunning vintage of Zinfandel is grown in the Templeton Gap Sub-AVA of Paso Robles. This western terroir is characterized by cooler days and nights provided by the ocean breeze and fog rolling in from Morro Bay. While the Templeton Gap has notably cooler temperatures compared to other areas of Paso Robles, it is still relatively hot and dry which helps varietals like Zinfandel to really thrive. The cool ocean air provides a balance of temperatures that allows the fruit to hang on the vines longer and develop more complex flavors.

This medium-full bodied wine is high in fruity flavors, bursting with rich aromas of blackberry and plums. Only neutral French oak was used in this 15-month barrel aging, so that all the fresh, fruit flavors of this wine could shine.

TASTING & PAIRINGS

Our 2022 vintage of Bianchi Signature Selection Zinfandel is sure to captivate an audience with its bold and luscious flavor profile. Aromas of ripe blackberries and cherries mingle with hints of vanilla and baking spices, enticing the senses. This wine unfolds with rich flavors of dark plum, raspberry jam and a touch of cocoa, framed by velvety, mild tannins that provide structure and balance. A subtle undertone of pepper adds complexity, leading to a satisfying finish with lingering fruit and a touch of oak.

Enjoy this bottle with a hearty and flavorful meal or a decadent cheese board. Smoked brisket or barbecued ribs pair perfectly with this wine, as does a margherita pizza, a slow-cooked Bolognese, or your favorite dark chocolate dessert.
